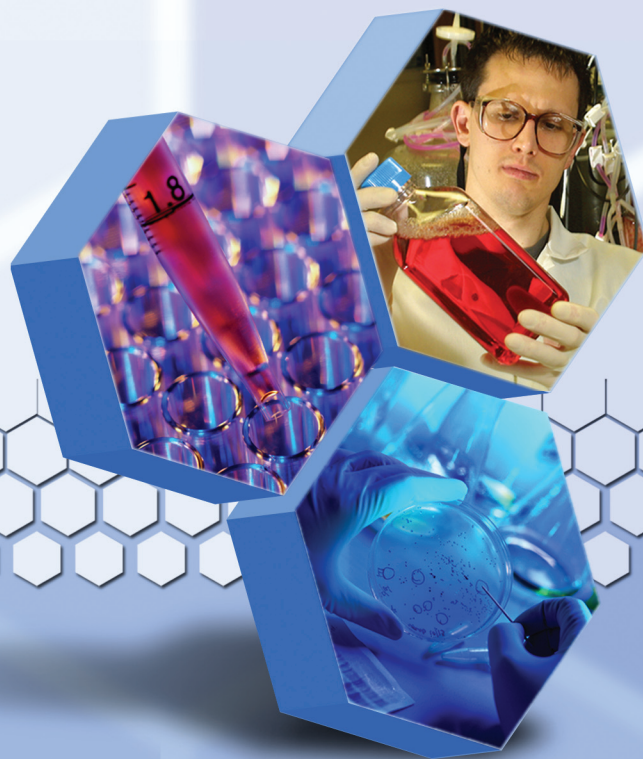

John H. Cunningham is the Senior Vice President of Development at Alexandria Real Estate Equities, Inc. Mr. Cunningham has 20 years of experience in real estate development, and has completed over 4 million square feet of space, including numerous complex life science and specialized high-tech projects, large build-to-suits and strategic properties.

Prior to joining Alexandria, Mr. Cunningham was at Cambridge Development Group in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area since 1987, where he became the president in 1995. While at Cambridge, Mr. Cunningham worked closely with Alexandria from 1997 to 2007, acting as a third party developer on projects in the Mid-Atlantic region of the United States. In addition to development, Mr. Cunningham has extensive experience in acquiring and leasing existing commercial real estate. Prior to Cambridge, Mr. Cunningham was the editor-in-chief of *The Pro Review* magazine, a publication for professional photographers. He is also the Vice Chairman of the Board of Trustees for Loudoun Country Day School, and the founder for I Support Adoption, Inc. a nonprofit company established to promote adoption. Mr. Cunningham received his Bachelor of Arts in International Relations from the University of Maryland. Mr. Cunningham joined Alexandria in January 2007.
